

Chester County High School Graduation Requirements

All students receiving a Regular diploma from the State of Tennessee shall complete the Core Curriculum plus either the University Preparation Curriculum or the Technical Preparation Curriculum.

22 credits are required to graduate from Chester County High School.

* One math course must be Algebra I and one must be Geometry. University Path must take Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II.

** One of the three science courses must be Biology I and one must be a physical science, such as Physical Science, Chemistry, or Physics.

*** The social studies curriculum shall include U. S. History, World History, Economics, and U. S. Government.
